## AES UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

AES requires sixty (60) credits to fulfill the AES Major Requirements.

Thirty (30) credits will come from the two Core courses area:

**AES Core Courses:** fifteen credits must come from: [15]

- AES 150 Introductory History of American Ethnic Groups (5) I&S
- AES 151 Introduction to the Cultures of American Ethnic Groups (5) I&S
- AES 212 Comparative American Ethnic Literature (5) I&S/VLPA
